As you state correctly in your letter, Local Public Health Departments can only regulate activities related to food employees. The WI Food Code does not address requirements for dress or footwear for guests/patrons that visit a business. However, a business can institute policies that require certain activities.

You are correct that Outagamie County would not require a sign to be posted that describes how guests/patrons should dress or requirements for foot wear.
