Dear Mr. Kelman,

Thank you for your inquiry. You asked if the State Health Department would answer questions for you; however, you sent your questions to the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD). The SNHD is not the parent agency for the Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, and therefore is not in a position to answer your questions as they pertain to the State Health Department. The SNHD is the public health agency of jurisdiction for Clark County, Nevada for some of the regulated facilities. We are authorized to regulate and inspect under the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS), Chapter 439. We inspect facilities that are required, under statute, to hold permits with the SNHD such as food establishments, childcare facilities, body art facilities, public accommodations, individual septic disposal systems, landfills, recycling facilities, and schools. We also provide services related to illegal food sales and illegal waste dumping. Permitted facilities are inspected at a frequency mandated by the various NRS chapters governing the particular facility type. The facilities you mentioned, general offices, call centers, and radio stations, are not generally required to have permits with the SNHD and will not receive inspection services by the SNHD.

Appropriate dress for employees in the various regulated establishments depends on the facility type. I am not aware of any regulatory dress requirement for patrons. Please understand that other agencies may have requirements and would possibly have some type of enforcement ability if those requirements are not observed.
